Placement and Accessibility of Portable Toilets




Signage Design and Visibility Requirements



Frequently Asked Questions

What are the minimum required signs for portable toilets at events?

Each portable toilet must have gender designation signs (if separated), handicap accessibility symbols (where applicable), and occupancy indicators. Emergency contact information should also be visible.

How large should portable toilet signs be to meet ADA requirements?

ADA-compliant signs should be mounted 60 inches from the ground to the signs center, with letters at least 1 inch tall and symbols at least 6 inches tall for clear visibility.

What languages should be included on portable toilet signs at public events? Signs should be in English and any other predominant languages spoken in the area. For large events, using universal symbols alongside text is recommended. Where should directional signs for portable toilets be placed at events? Directional signs should be placed at main walkways, every 100 feet along paths, and at all major gathering points, with arrows pointing to toilet locations. What safety information must be displayed on or near portable toilets? Safety signs must include handwashing instructions, emergency contact numbers, servicing company information, and any relevant hazard warnings or chemical notices.
